The man behind the Pentagon Papers, and bestselling, award-winning author. He is an activist on the dangers of the nuclear era and the urgent need for whistleblowing.

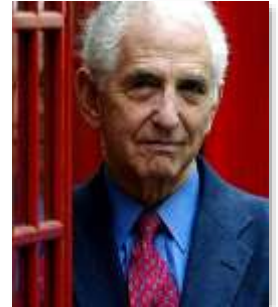
This event is for all writers of fiction, nonfiction and children's writing.
